Co-host this conference – Make a difference

Strategic Imperatives for Ending Violence against Women: Linkages to Education, Economic Security, and Health is a conference that will bring together research, program and advocacy experts to strategize on initiatives to end violence against women. The conference will be held June 11-12, 2010 at Hunter College in New York City (Manhattan). Convened as a partnership between the National Council for Research on Women and the US National Committee for UNIFEM, the series of panels and workshops will be hosted by The Women and Gender Studies Program and Roosevelt House at Hunter College. The conference will seek to build collaborations, bringing together business, academic, philanthropic, advocacy, nonprofit and policy communities to take action. Participants will explore the intersections between violence against women and key social investments: in economic security, health, and education.

Why should we co-host this conference?

Co-hosting is an option for organizations that cannot contribute at the sponsor level of \$1000 or more but that still want to play an active role. Contributors will have a unique opportunity to network and form strong alliances for building future initiatives.

Co-hosts will be listed in the program and on all conference and post-conference materials as important supporters of the conference. In addition to visibility, co-hosts gain access to contacts and potential partners for follow up work. Conference outcomes will include strategies for strengthening public awareness and advocacy. Direct service organizations will have opportunities to connect with potential donors and others who might be interested in supporting their work.

By co-hosting, organizations show they care -- they want to make a difference.

What is required of co-hosts?

Only two actions are required:

1. With a **contribution of \$400**, you will receive **two complimentary passes** for the conference. These can be distributed to staff, volunteers, or supporters. **For \$500** you will also receive two passes for the **USNC reception honoring** the First World Conference on Women.
